Monday, April 3rd, The Rotary Club of Sandy Springs welcomed City Manager of Sandy Springs, Eden Freeman.



Eden Freeman began her service as City Manager of Sandy Springs on January 17th, 2022. As City Manager, she is responsible for oversight of daily operations of the City Government, achieving Council's adopted priorities, implementing Council policies, and coordinating community issues in a City with an all funds budget of than \$995 million.



Freeman updated the Club on some of the most recent developments going on in our city including:

- Updates on the construction [Veterans Park](#) and the surrounding traffic pattern
- New [Fire Station No. 5](#) going in on the north side of the city at 7800 Mount Vernon Road
- Local Option Sales Tax ([LOST](#)) renewal
- The current state of the "[Water War](#)" going on with City of Atlanta

Freeman also noted that Sandy Springs was recently named the 9th best river town in which to retire in the South by Southern Living. It has also been named by other publication as a city on the move and a city worth watching.

JOIN SANDY SPRINGS PICKLEBALL TOURNAMENT



The Rotary Club of Sandy Springs is hosting a Pickleball fundraiser on April 14 at the Sandy Springs Tennis Center near the intersection of Roswell Road and Abernathy. A portion of the proceeds will go to one of our community partners, Vision To Learn. Vision To Learn is a not-for-profit organization that provides free eye exams and glasses to children in low-income communities across the United States. This year, the Rotary Club of Sandy Springs partnered with Vision to Learn, and our club donated more than 800 pair of eyeglasses to elementary and middle school students in Sandy Springs.

Our club is now registering players for the Pickleball Madness Tournament. All skill levels are accepted. If you've never played Pickleball before you can pick it up in mere minutes - I played just one

time a few weeks ago for an hour and I'm ready to play! Our tournament will be played by doubles using a round robin format. You'll be able to play in about three matches. You don't need a partner to play as we'll pair you with someone of similar skill. If you don't have a paddle, one will be provided. Below are the key details of the tournament:

1. Tournament Date: 4/14
2. Tournament Time: Begins at 2:30
3. Tournament Cost: \$75/player (will include a t-shirt and SWAG bag depending upon the sponsors)
4. Tournament Number of Players: Max 80 - (tournament is coed, round robin and double-blind draw)
5. Tournament Location: Sandy Springs Tennis Center
6. Pickleball Skills Level: Beginner and above - (we'll match players to their skill level)
7. Acrylic Awards to the top three male and female point totals
